



H-E-B Scholarship Eligibility

Academic Year 2024-2025

Eligibility Requirements

1. Scholarships are only applicable for currently recognized **Title 1 Schools**
2. Scholarships are applicable to **students only**; teachers and chaperones must pay \$10 each for admission with a count of no less than 1 adult per 10 students
3. Scholarships are applicable for **Introduction to Aviation** field trips (standard museum tour only); additional experiences carry a cost per student
4. Scholarships are applicable to Field Trips **arriving between September 24, 2024 and December 31, 2024 occurring on Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday**; Friday is not an eligible day (Museum is closed on Monday)
5. Scholarships are applicable in the amount of **no more than 100 students per school** (not 100 students per field trip per school); schools which bring more than 100 students may pay the standard field trip rates for the count over 100

Reservation Procedures

1. Reservations and final counts for student admissions and for lunches must be made **no less than 3 weeks in advance** of field trip date
2. Scholarship Field Trip reservations requests open on September 4, 2024
3. Scholarship Field Trip reservations will end on December 10, 2024 or when funds are depleted; whichever is first
4. Reservation requests must be **submitted through the online booking form** at <https://lonestarflight.org/learn/field-trips/#field-trip-form>
5. Reservation request submittals for scholarships must type "**H.E.B. Scholarship Request**" in the Comment/Additional Notes field on the online reservation form

Lunchtime

1. **Group leaders and/or additional chaperones are to distribute the pre-packed lunches** with the following items:
 - Turkey Sandwich or Ham Sandwich (provided by H-E-B)
 - Fruit (provided by H-E-B)
 - Bottle of Water (provided by H-E-B)
 - Napkins (provided by the school)
2. Due to the volume of lunches, **special dietary needs cannot be accommodated**; students with special dietary needs are encouraged to pack their own lunch and the school is to reduce the lunch count so no food is wasted
3. Lunch schedules may not be able to accommodate the entire group at the same time or in the same room
4. All trash and recyclables must be placed in the proper receptacle by the students and chaperones
5. All items brought to the museum must be carried per person; no storage or refrigeration is available
