These twins may be small, but they love shiny planes so they can see their own reflection.



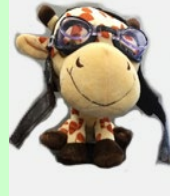
Propwash ☐

I'm in an aircraft that looks just like me!

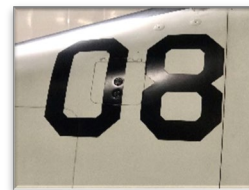
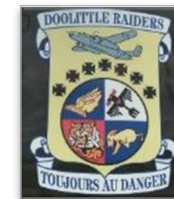
